Task-Based Language Teaching (TBLT) emerged from the principles of CLT and focuses on the use of meaningful tasks as the central component of language



learning. Ellis defines a task as an activity that requires learners to use the target language to achieve a specific outcome. TBLT has been shown to enhance learner engagement and motivation, as tasks often reflect real-world scenarios Willis Willis [5.39]. Studies suggest that TBLT can lead to improved language acquisition, particularly in developing speaking and listening skills Samuda Bygate. However, implementing TBLT can be challenging due to the need for careful task design and assessment.

The integration of technology into English language teaching has transformed traditional methodologies, offering new avenues for engagement and interaction. Computer-assisted language learning (CALL) tools, online platforms, and mobile applications have made language learning more accessible and flexible Chapelle, 2003. Research indicates that technology can facilitate collaborative learning and provide immediate feedback, which enhances learner autonomy Godwin-Jones [5.98]. However, educators must be mindful of the digital divide and ensure that all students have equitable access to technological resources.

Incorporating cultural sensitivity into English language teaching is essential for creating inclusive learning environments. Kramsch argues that language is inherently tied to culture, and effective language instruction must acknowledge and respect the diverse backgrounds of learners. Culturally responsive pedagogy encourages educators to integrate cultural content into their curricula, fostering students' sense of belonging and engagement Ladson-Billings. Additionally, recognizing linguistic diversity within the classroom can help address the needs of multilingual learners and promote an appreciation for different dialects and varieties of English [6.69].
